PROHIBITING SALE OF LIQUOR ON OR NEAR UNIVERSITY GROUNDS.

An Act prohibiting the sale of intoxicating liquors on or near the grounds of the University of Washington and amending section 1 of chapter 75, of the Laws of 1895.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Amends § 1, ch. 75, Laws 1895. Section 1. That section 1, chapter 75 of the Laws of 1895 (section 5100 of Remington's Revised Statutes) be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Unlawful to sell intoxicating liquors on university grounds. Section 1. It shall be unlawful to sell any intoxicating liquors, with or without a license, on the grounds of the University of Washington, or within the district bounded by Lake Washington canal on the south, Eighth avenue N. E. on the west, East 52nd street on the north, and Lake Washington on the east thereof, and any license granted for the sale of such intoxicating liquors within said area shall be void. Said grounds of the University of Washington are otherwise known and described as follows: Fractional section 16, township 25 north, range 4 east of Willamette Meridian.
