REAPPROPRIATION FOR SECONDARY STATE HIGHWAYS.

AN ACT reappropriating a certain sum from the motor vehicle fund for salaries, operations, administration, construction, reconstruction, location, alteration, repair, improvement and maintenance of secondary state highways, and declaring that this act shall take effect immediately.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby reappropriated Re-approfrom the motor vehicle fund for the use of the Director of Highways and the Department of Highways for salaries, operations, administration, construction, reconstruction, location, alteration, repair, improvement and maintenance of the secondary state highways, and for all other proper secondary state highway purposes, the sum of one million five hundred eighty-nine thousand three hundred twenty and 85/100 dollars (\$1,589,320.85), the same being the unexpended balance of the appropriation contained in section 3, chapter 206, Laws of 1937, as shown by the State Auditor's books on December 31, 1938: *Provided*, That no expenditure under the authority of this act shall exceed the unexpended balance of the appropriation contained in section 3, chapter 206, Laws of 1937.

SEC. 2. That this act is necessary for the im- Effective immediately. mediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and the support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take effect immediately.
