## LIMITATION OF ACTIONS AFFECTING PERSONS IN MILITARY SERVICE.

An Act relating to limitation of actions, affecting persons in military service, amending section 39 of the Code of 1881 (section 171. Remington's Revised Statutes).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Amendments. Section 1. Section 39 of the Code of 1881 (section 171, Remington's Revised Statutes) is hereby amended to read as follows:

Limitation of action extended.

Section 39. (a) When a person shall be an alien subject or a citizen of a country at war with the United States, the time of the continuance of the war shall not be a part of the period limited for the commencement of the action.

Military service extends limitation. (b) When the enforcement of civil liabilities against a person in the military service of the United States has been suspended by operation of law, the period of such suspension shall not be a part of the period limited for the commencement of the action.
