## CHAPTER 103.

SALE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY OF STATE COLLEGE OF WASHINGTON.

An Acr relating to the State College of Washington and authorizing the sale of certain property on the Campus thereof to the United States of America.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Sale authorized. Section 1. In order to enable the establishment in this state of a light metals experimental laboratory by the Federal Government on the Campus of the State College of Washington, at Pullman, authority is hereby granted to the Regents of said College to sell to the United States of America the new Engineering Laboratories Building and the site upon which it stands on said Campus at private sale and at such price as may be agreed upon by the Regents of said College.

Governor to sign deed.

Sec. 2. The conveyance of said property shall be evidenced by a deed thereof signed by the Governor and attested by the Secretary of State.

Money to general fund.

SEC. 3. The money derived from said sale shall be immediately transmitted to the State Treasurer to be deposited to the credit of the General Fund.
