

## CHAPTER 164.

[ S. B. 251. ]

DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATION—CENTRAL STORES  
REVOLVING FUND.

AN ACT making a deficiency appropriation for the Central Stores Revolving Fund for the Department of Finance, Budget and Business; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:*

SECTION 1. By reason of a deficiency existing in the Central Stores Revolving Fund and in the appropriations made by the Twenty-eighth Legislature, there is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the General Fund in the State Treasury the sum of four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000), to the Department of Finance, Budget and Business for the purpose of increasing the Central Stores Revolving Fund operating capital.

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate support of the state government and its existing public institutions and shall take effect immediately.
