SCHOLARSHIPS.

An Act authorizing the University of Washington and Washington State College to award scholarships and certain fee exemptions to students and graduates of foreign friendly higher educational institutions, provided similar reciprocal privileges are exchanged.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Scholarships granted by University and State College. Section 1. The University of Washington and Washington State College shall each have the authority to award, during each academic year, not to exceed fifty (50) scholarships, to students or graduates of universities or colleges of friendly foreign nations, and exempting such recipients from the payment of tuition, library and incidental fees for the scholarship period: *Provided*, That the University and State College obtain satisfactory assurance that educational institutions of the said friendly foreign nations will exchange now or in the future reciprocal privileges to a similar number of students or graduates of the University of Washington or Washington State College.
