CLAIMS AGAINST STATE OR MUNICIPALITIES— NOTARIAL SEAL DISPENSED WITH

An Act relating to claims for services, materials or merchandise furnished the state government and political sub-divisions thereof; dispensing with notarial acknowledgment on such claims; defining crimes and prescribing penalties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. It shall not be necessary in filing any Acknowledgclaim for services, materials or merchandise furnished the State of Washington or any of its political sub-divisions that the claim shall be signed and sworn to before a notary public: Provided, That no such claim shall be filed or paid unless the claimant shall sign a statement that the services, materials or merchandise has been furnished and that the claim is just, due and unpaid. Any person signing such statement which is false or untrue shall be deemed guilty of second degree perjury.
