DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATION—JUNIOR COLLEGES.

An Act making a deficiency appropriation for assistance to Junior Colleges as provided by chapter 63, Laws of 1943 (section 4623-9, Remington's Revised Statutes, Supplement, also Pierce's Perpetual Code 895-17), and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Appropriation. Section 1. By reason of a deficiency existing in the appropriation made by the Twenty-ninth Regular Session of the Legislature, the following sum or so much thereof as shall be found necessary is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund of the State Treasury, for the fiscal biennium beginning April 1, 1945, and ending March 31, 1947:

For the State Board of Education:

To be expended in accordance with the provisions of chapter 63, Laws of 1943 (section 4623-9, Remington's Revised Statutes, Supplement, also Pierce's Perpetual Code

895-17), relating to Junior Colleges..... \$65,132.38

Effective immediately.

Sec. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, support of the state government and its existing public institutions and shall take effect immediately.
