CHAPTER 17. [S. B. 93.]

DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATIONS.

An Acr making deficiency appropriations for the Washington State Penitentiary, the Western State Hospital, and the Northern State Hospital as provided by law, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Section 1. By reason of deficiencies existing in Deficiency appropriathe appropriations made by the Twenty-Ninth Regular Session of the Legislature, the following sums, or so much thereof as shall severally be found necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the General Fund of the state treasury, for the fiscal biennium beginning April 1, 1945, and ending March 31, 1947:

FOR THE WASHINGTON STATE PENITENTIARY: Salaries and wages..... \$1,100 \$83,900 FOR THE WESTERN STATE HOSPITAL: Salaries and wages..... \$80,000 FOR THE NORTHERN STATE HOSPITAL: Salaries, wages and operations..... \$216,500

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate Emergency. preservation of the public peace, health and safety, support of the state government and its existing public institutions and shall take effect immediately.
