## CHAPTER 208. [S.B. 355.]

## ELECTIONS—CANCELLED REGISTRATIONS. AN ACT relating to elections; and adding a new section to chapter 29.10, R.C.W.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

New section.

Statement as to can-cellation of

registrations.

SECTION 1. There is hereby added to chapter 29.10, R.C.W., a new section to read as follows:

On or before August first of the odd numbered year, each county auditor, city or town clerk, shall execute a sworn statement and file same with the secretary of state within ten days after date of execution. Said statement shall be furnished by the office of secretary of state and shall be in substantially the following form:

STATE OF WASHINGTON, COUNTY OF.....

...., do solemnly swear I, ..... that I have caused to be examined the permanent voting record of each registered voter under my jurisdiction and have cancelled those registrations of said voters who have failed to cast a ballot at any election held during the four year period immediately prior to the first day of April of this year as provided by law.

Further, the number of said cancellations totaled ...... A notice has been mailed to each elector concerned and the office of the secretary has been notified of said cancellations as reported on Permanent Registration Form No. 8.
