CHAPTER 20.

TIMBER VALUATION MANUAL.

[S. B. 21.]

An Act relating to taxation, authorizing the tax commission to prepare and distribute a timber valuation manual; and making an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Section 1. The tax commission is authorized Timber valuation and directed to formulate, prepare, and publish a timber valuation manual, embodying such rules and processes for the assessment of timber for tax purposes as are best calculated to secure uniform assessment of property of like kind and value in the various taxing units of the state. Upon completion of the manual, the commission shall furnish copies thereof to each county auditor and assessor free of charge, and to all others at a price of two dollars and fifty cents.

Sec. 2. To carry out the provisions of this act there is hereby appropriated to the tax commission from the general fund for the biennium ending March 31, 1953, the sum of eight thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary.
