STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION—CONVEYANCE OF LANDS.

AN Act authorizing the state highway commission to deed parcels of land not needed for highway purposes to abutting property owners in consideration for other lands needed for highway purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Whenever the state department of Highway highways shall have title to any parcel of land which the state highway commission shall determine is not necessary for highway purposes, the commission is authorized to cause such land to be deeded to the owner of land abutting upon such parcel in consideration, or partial consideration, for other lands owned by such property owner which the highway commission deems to be necessary for highway purposes. The governor is authorized to execute and the secretary of state shall attest the conveyances necessary to carry out such exchange.
