LOG PATROLS—UNLAWFUL AREAS OF OPERATION.

AN ACT relating to log patrols and amending section 9, chapter 140, Laws of 1953 and RCW 76.40.020.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Section 9, chapter 140, Laws of 1953 and RCW 76.40.020 are each amended to read as follows: Amendment.

From and after June 11, 1953 it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, association or corporation to directly or indirectly engage in the activities of a log patrol on or adjacent to the waters of this state, except that area in the state of Washington on the Columbia River above Grand Coulee Dam drained by the Columbia River and its tributaries, and except as hereinafter provided. Unlawful areas of operation.
