SEWER DISTRICT COMMISSIONERS.

AN ACT relating to sewer district commissioners; and amending section 8, chapter 140, Laws of 1945 and RCW 56.12.010.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Section 8, chapter 140, Laws of 1945 Amendment. and RCW 56.12.010 are each amended to read as follows:

The governing body of a sewer district shall be a sewer district board of commissioners consisting of three mem- missioners. bers. The commissioners shall annually elect one of their number as president and another as secretary of the board.

A district may provide by resolution for the pay- Compensation. ment of compensation to each of its commissioners at a rate not exceeding ten dollars for each day or major part thereof devoted to the business of the district. In addition, the secretary may be paid a reasonable sum for his services as secretary and for bookkeeping work and keeping the records of the district.

The board shall by resolution adopt rules govern- Board duties ing the transaction of its business and shall adopt an official seal. All proceedings shall be by resolution recorded in a book kept for that purpose, which shall be a public record.
