PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION—RAILROAD
EMPLOYEES.

AN ACT relating to transportation and directing the public service commission to adopt and enforce necessary sanitary rules and regulations for the protection of the health of railroad employees, and adding a new section to chapter 117, Laws of 1911 and chapter 81.04 RCW.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. There is added to chapter 117, Laws of 1911 and to chapter 81.04 RCW, a new section to read as follows: New section.

The public service commission shall adopt and enforce rules and regulations relating to sanitation and adequate shelter as it affects the health of all railroad employees, including but not limited to railroad trainmen, enginemen, yardmen, maintenance of way employees, highway crossing watchmen, clerical, platform, freight house and express employees. Railroad employees—Sanitation, shelter.

Passed the House February 22, 1957.

Passed the Senate March 6, 1957.

Approved by the Governor March 11, 1957.
