APPROPRIATION—MALE CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION.

An Acr Relating to state government; creating the charitable, educational, penal and reformatory institutions account in the general fund; amending section 3, chapter 170, Laws of 1961 (uncodified), making an appropriation, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Section 3, chapter 170, Laws of 1961 1961 c 170 § 3 (uncodified), is amended to read as follows:

amended.

For the purpose of retiring the bonds issued Appropriation. pursuant to chapter 23, Laws of 1961, first extraordinary session (Senate Bill No. 5) to finance the construction of the correctional institution established by chapter 214, Laws of 1959 (chapter 72.13 RCW), there is appropriated from the charitable, educational, penal and reformatory institutions account of the general fund to the state building construction bond redemption fund created by chapter 298, Laws of 1957, the sum of seven million five hundred thousand dollars, or so much as may be necessary.

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate Emergency. preservation of the public peace, health and safety, the support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take effect immediately.
