GRAND JURY PROCEEDINGS—ATTORNEYS—APPEARANCE.

AN ACT relating to criminal procedure; authorizing attorneys to appear at grand jury proceedings; and adding a new section to chapter 10.28 RCW.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

New section.

Section 1. There is added to chapter 10.28 RCW a new section to read as follows:

Grand jury proceedings— Witnesses' right to attorney—Limitation. During any time that a witness appears before a grand jury, he shall be entitled to the presence of an attorney to advise him: *Provided*, That said attorney shall only advise such witness concerning his right to answer or not answer any questions asked of such witness and shall not engage in the proceedings in any other manner. Such attorney shall be considered an officer of the court in accordance with RCW 10.28.210.
