CHAPTER 90 [Engrossed Senate Bill No. 858] DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES--DISPOSITION OF LANDS IN COWLITZ AND MASON COUNTIES

AN ACT Relating to the exchange and transfer of certain lands under the jurisdiction of the department of natural resources.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 1. The department of natural resources is authorized, with the advice and approval of the state board of natural resources, to exchange any lands acquired pursuant to RCW 76.12.030 located in Cowlitz county for lands of equal value owned by the International Paper Company which are adjacent to Seaguest State Park in Cowlitz county. In the event of such exchange the lands acquired by the state shall be held and administered in the same manner as were the lands exchanged therefor.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. The department of natural resources shall have the authority to deed the Mason County Cemetery District No. 1 an area not to exceed one acre of state forest lands utilized for cemetery purposes located in section 30, township 23 north, range 1 west, Willamette Meridian, Mason county.
