CHAPTER 34

[HOUSE BILL NO. 428] BENTON-FRANKLIN MENTAL HEALTH CENTER--WHATCOM FAMILY SERVICE CENTER--APPROPRIATIONS

AN ACT Relating to mental health; making an appropriation; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund for the biennium ending June 30, 1975, the sum of seventy-six thousand one hundred seventy-one dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used for the construction of the Benton-Franklin mental health and family counseling center located at Richland, Washington.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated from the state general fund for the biennium ending June 30, 1975, the sum of fifty-seven thousand ninety-nine dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used for the construction of the Whatcom family service center located at Bellingham, Washington.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. This 1973 act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, the support of state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take effect immediately.
