The commission shall make ((an annual)) a biennial report of its proceedings and recommendations to the governor, which shall contain a full description of program and project activity, including fund sources and expenditures for the biennium covered by the report.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 9. The following acts or parts of acts are each repealed:

- (1) Section 43.46.010, chapter 8, Laws of 1965 and RCW 43.46.010;

<u>NEW SECTION</u>. Sec. 10. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, the support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take effect June 30, 1985.

CHAPTER 318

[Senate Bill No. 3202]

BUILDING PERMITS TO CONTAIN COUNTY ASSESSOR PARCEL NUMBER

AN ACT Relating to counties; and amending RCW 36.21.060.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Sec. 1. Section 36.21.060, chapter 4, Laws of 1963 and RCW 36.21-.060 are each amended to read as follows:

Whenever any issuer issues a building permit for the construction of any building, such issuer shall immediately transmit a copy of the permit to the county assessor of the county in which such building is to be constructed. The building permit shall contain the county assessor's parcel number where available.
