# Ferries Division Headquarters Staffing Changes

#### **Budgeted Positions:**

- **290.25** (2005-07)
- **264.75** (current)
- 25.5 reduction or -9%

#### **Consultant Costs:**

- **\$43,449,000 (2005-07)**
- **\$12,468,000 (current)**
- 71.3% reduction

Total savings = \$31,595,000

# **Capital Costs**

- \$106 million was reduced from the baseline terminals preservation program as a result of updating the Life Cycle Cost Model
- At legislative direction reduced capital cost by \$4.3M for FY09
- Consultant use is under review to determine cost effectiveness
