I am writing because you recently received the following traffic violation:

You are the future of our state and nation and I care about you. On behalf of DOL, I want to take this opportunity to remind you that personal responsibility and knowledge of our traffic laws are major parts of being a safe driver.

Recent research here in Washington tells us that a traffic violation doubles your risk for being involved in a car wreck. Not paying attention to the road or careless decisions while driving can cause serious injuries or death to you—and to those around you.

Most Washington drivers go years without a traffic violation. While you may be a good and safe driver most of the time, this violation could reflect at least a momentary lapse in driving judgment. At highway speeds, your car travels the length of a football field in a couple of seconds, and a moment of carelessness or distraction can quickly become a tragedy.
