ISSUES LIST

Direction on this list of key issues, as well as survey responses, will inform our work on Tasks 5, 6, and 7.

- 1. RCW 90.03.525 Barriers and Efficiencies
 - Need to charge municipal streets in order to charge WSDOT: Could eliminate requirement or maintain it.
 - Justification and reporting requirements are onerous: Could streamline with standardized reporting, or eliminate in favor of uniform WSDOT rate periodically set (see 2.a.iii below).
 - Provide written guidance, and potentially training, on what is appropriate for WSDOT charge justification and what is not.

2. RCW 90.03.525 Perceived Inequities

- WSDOT 70% credit for limited access highways not fair/justified: Could...
 - eliminate credit [charge WSDOT like any other property];
 - don't charge WSDOT because no other states do;
 - change credit based on documented justification;
 - set special standard WSDOT rates for eastern and western Washington based on justification documentation.
- Provide ability for municipalities to charge WSDOT for non-limited access highways.

3. Other Issues

- NPDES responsibility clarification/segregation.
- M&O efficiencies.
