Bold Notice In the Proposal Form

IS YOUR DISADVANAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE) DOCUMENTATION INCLUDED AS NOTED BELOW???

(AS REQUIRED BY THE SPECIFICATIONS)

IF NOT

YOUR BID MAY BE CONSIDERED NONRESPONSIVE AND WILL BE REJECTED

YOU MUST INCLUDE;

- 1. <u>THE DISADVANAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE UTILIZATION</u> <u>CERTIFICATION</u> FORM #272-056 EF WHICH DEMONSTRATES HOW YOU INTEND TO MEET THE DBE CONDITION OF AWARD GOAL. IN THE EVENT YOU CANNOT MEET THE GOAL SEE NUMBER THREE BELOW.
- 2. YOU MUST SUBMIT A <u>DISADVANAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE</u> (DBE) WRITTEN CONFIRMATION DOCUMENT FORM #422-031 EF FROM EACH AND EVERY DBE LISTED IN THE UTILIZATION CERTIFICATION

NOTE: THIS IS THE ONLY DOCUMENT SUBJECT TO THE "Deadline for Receipt of DBE Written Confirmation Document(s)."

3. AND ONLY IN THE EVENT YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO INDICATE IN YOUR DBE UTILIZATION CERTIFICATION <u>THAT YOU MET THE</u> <u>GOAL</u>; YOU MUST SUBMIT YOUR <u>GOOD FAITH EFFORT</u> <u>DOCUMENTATION</u> (AS DESCRIBED IN THE DBE SPECIFICATION)

How do contractors know what work a DBE is certified to perform?

WSDOT Created the <u>Resource List</u>

- The list is guaranteed as accurate within seven days of bid opening.
- Any DBE may get on the list for work they are NAICS certified to perform.
- WSDOT Office of Equal Opportunity manages the list.

How do contractors get a written confirmation from the DBEs prior to submitting the bid?

Three Hour Bid Delay

- Bids remain sealed
- The written confirmation document is the only document subject to the delay
