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# King County roads

The County road system is valued at \$39 billion, and was built over generations.

- Roads
- Bridges
- Sidewalks
- Traffic signals
- Culverts



## What's the problem?


### Revenue has declined significantly

- Lower property values mean lower road tax revenues
- Fuel-efficient cars, and fewer people driving means lower gas tax revenue
- Less tax revenue means less service




### How is it different than we expected?

# Key assets failing



### What does it mean?

#### Less maintenance work

Reduced preventative maintenance will lead to more expensive fixes later

#### Reduced storm and disaster response

Snow and ice



# What are we doing now?

- Focusing our remaining resources on safety and necessary maintenance
- Managing our work more efficiently
- Reducing costs by reducing service
- The Executive is proposing some short-term assistance in the 2013-14 county budget



### Preserving the Metro Transit System


- What we are doing:
  - \$385 million in reforms and efficiencies
  - Spending down reserves
  - Congestion Reduction Charge ends in 2014
- What is needed:
  - \*\$75 million per year in additional revenue to preserve current Metro-funded service


