

#### **Status of ongoing program realignment:**

- Design & Construct as planned
- Keep Moving: closely track schedule and cost uncertainties & risks
- Retain only limited funding to develop options
- Suspend: no activity, defund from finance plan
- Delete from program

University Link: 86% complete - approximately \$150M under budget and six months ahead of schedule








- Project Budget: \$383.2 million














