

## I-405 Traffic Is Getting Worse

#### Bad traffic

- Drivers on I-405 experience some of the worst traffic in the state, up to eight hours of congestion each day
- Today the southbound I-405 HOV lane drops below 45 mph 200 days out of the year and I-405 HOV lanes are congested 60 percent of weekdays
- By 2030, employment will grow by 50 percent and the area will see 25 percent more residents

### Crowded HOV Lanes

- I-405 HOV lanes are not meeting state and federal requirements to operate at 45 mph 90 percent of the time during peak hours
- I-405 HOV lanes are often just as congested as the regular lanes

### Transit Suffers

Congested lanes significantly delay transit trips and reduce reliability







- Bellevue to Lynnwood project (expected completion in 2015) is start of 40-mile corridor managed lanes system

The back bone to bus rapid transit (BRT)

#### Phase 1: Funded

- Bellevue to Lynnwood Widening and Express Toll Lanes – Opens early fall 2015
- SR 167 Stage 4 Planned to open 2017

#### Phase 2: Funded

- Renton to Bellevue Widening and Express Toll Lanes
- I-405/SR 167 Direct Connector

#### Phase 2: Unfunded

SR 167 Stage 5 – \$35 M PE/ROW/CN



## **Next steps**

## Over \$1.3 billion of new investment in the I-405/SR 167 corridor

### √ Implement corridor priority projects

The SR 167 Direct Connector will be ready to start the design build procurement process this fall. WSDOT will continue to look for practical design opportunities during this procurement. Preliminary engineering and right-of-way work on Renton to Bellevue I-405 widening will continue until mid-2019 when construction is anticipated to begin. Over the next several biennia, work on the NE 124<sup>th</sup> and NE 132<sup>nd</sup> interchanges will begin as well.

#### √ Reconvene the I-405/SR 167 EAG

Engage stakeholders to guide this next phase of investment in I-405/SR 167 and identify next priorities in the corridor


### ✓ Work with transit partners to implement BRT

Partner with Sound Transit, King County Metro and Community Transit to implement the preferred mode for I-405






## Express Toll Lanes are used across the country as part of the solution to urban congestion



## What happened in Miami on I-95? Improved Performance in all Lanes




### What happened in San Diego on I-15? **Public Support**

## Principles of Express Toll Lanes "Why do they work?"




Based on the highest observed 5-minute flow rates (vehicle-per-mile-perlane) during 2011 and 2013

## **Customer Focused Statewide Consistency**

- Good To Go! electronic tolling: one transponder and one account for drivers to use all toll facilities
- Photo tolling: one billing as drivers use toll facilities (not available on SR 167, yet)
- Statewide policy toll systems should be simple, unified, and interoperable
- In 2014, WSDOT processed 36.1 million transactions with annual toll revenues of \$126.6 million
- By 2017, WSDOT expects to handle 97 million transactions with \$280 million in revenue


















## **Expectations for Opening - Variable Toll Rates** and Zones




