- 60 miles south of Vancouver, BC, Canada
- Urban area ~ 90,000 residents




Bellingham's Waterfront District

- Former Georgia-Pacific Pulp Mill & Tissue Processing Site
- 200-acres now under Port of Bellingham Ownership
- Master Plan and Development Agreement, 2002-2013
- Interlocal Agreement between Port and City
- Development beginning to occur in 2016
- Arterial street construction 2017-2018
- Expectation: Long-Term "Generational" Buildout




Waterfront Existing Conditions
