JTC Pilotage Best Practices Review, study update

Beth Redfield, Joint Transportation Committee Staff November 15, 2017 Project Background and Purpose Study required by 2017 Transportation Budget, directed the JTC to:

- review practices of the WA Board of Pilotage Commissioners (BPC)
- identify best practices and recommendations for:
 - Analytically driven tariff- and fee-setting processes
 - Increased pilot diversity
 - Board make-up
 - Most effective agency oversight.

Project Status

- September: BPC current practices white paper, Major Findings:
 - Process for BPC rate setting is not laid out in regulations
 - Rate methodology not established; Variables are not consistent
 - To address diversity, efforts need to start early in the wider marine industry which produces pilot applicants

Project Status, continued

- Currently working on Best Practices and Comparison to Washington white paper
- Next Steps: Recommendations
- Four meetings to date with the Staff Work Group
- Final due date for report is January 8, 2018
