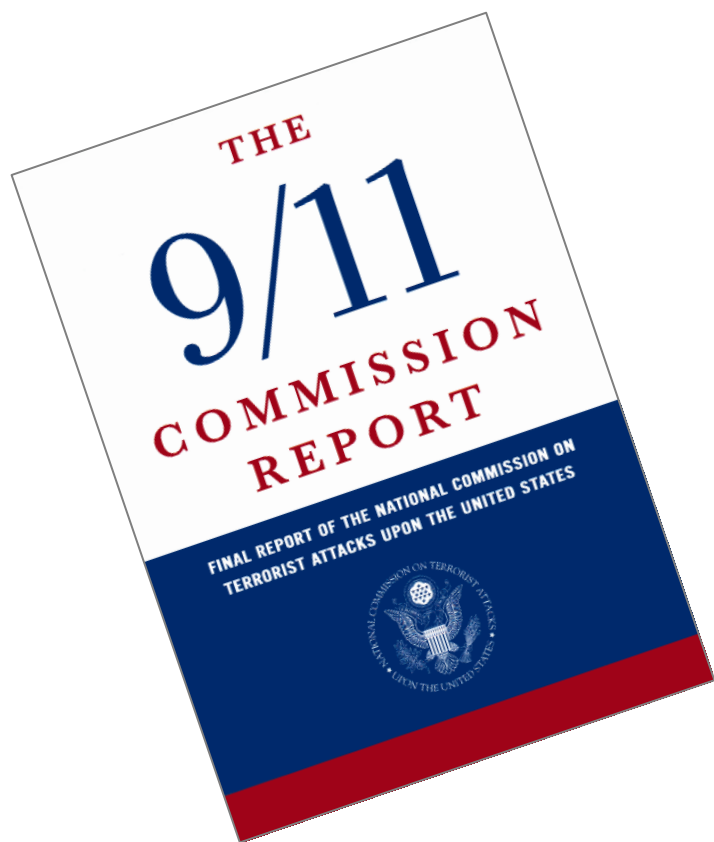

The 9/11 Commission Report (2004)



"The federal government should set standards for the issuance of birth certificates and sources of identification, such as driver's licenses."



Congress passed the Real ID Act in 2005

- *Established standards* for documents that will be accepted by federal agencies
- *States must meet standards* to be federally recognized as Real ID compliant and *have their state issued documents accepted for certain federal purposes*
- *A state can issue noncompliant documents* (like Washington's *standard driver's license/ID*), *but they must have distinct marking* limiting its federal usage

What federal purposes?



Real ID documents
will be required
for:

- Domestic air travel (boarding a plane at a TSA security checkpoint)
- Access to certain federal facilities (e.g., military bases)
- Access to nuclear power plants

Real ID compliant document requirements:

- Require *proof* of identity & lawful status
- Specific card *design features*
- *Safeguards* for issuance and production of licenses



Real ID *does not*:

- Create national identification card
- Authorize Department of Homeland Security (DHS) to regulate issuance of driver's licenses
- Prevent states from issuing noncompliant driver's licenses or identification cards as long as they are marked



A new Washington law passed in 2017.

It expects Washington to become a Real ID compliant state, and:



- **Lowered cost** of enhanced driver's license (EDL)/enhanced identification card (EID)
- **Requires DOL to begin marking** standard driver's license/standard identification cards beginning July 1, 2018 in a Real ID compliant way
- Mandates that the standard marking **cannot** be used as "evidence or as a basis to infer an individual's citizenship or immigration status for any purpose."

No one *has to* get an enhanced driver's license/ID

It's **optional**

Anyone can still choose a standard driver's license/ID



For domestic flights, ***you may already have*** the documents you need to be ready for Real ID on October 1, 2020:

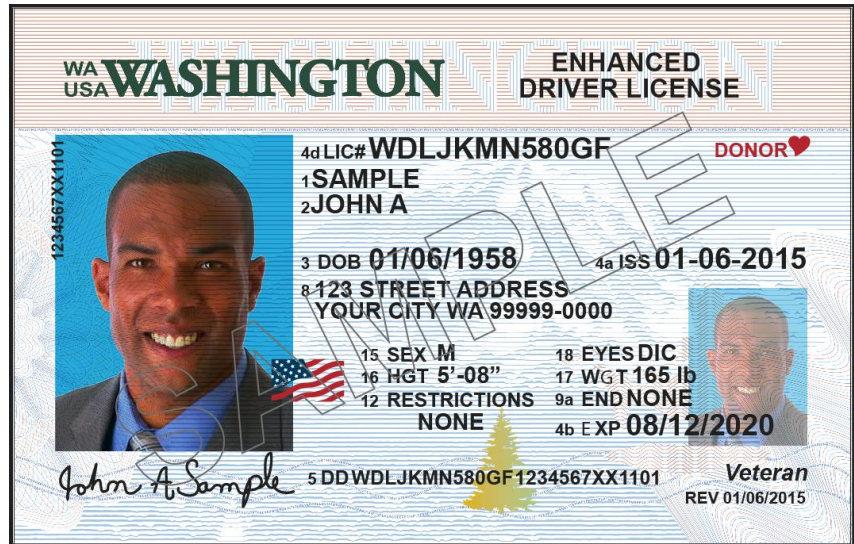


- U.S. passport/passport card
- Foreign government-issued passport
- Federally recognized, tribal-issued photo ID
- Permanent resident card
- U.S. Department of Defense ID (military IDs)
- DHS trusted traveler cards (Global Entry, NEXUS, SENTRI, FAST)

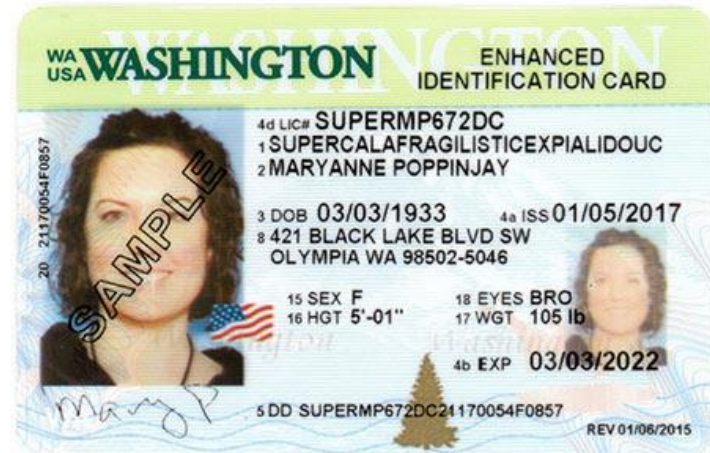
Washington issued **Real ID compliant** documents:

- Enhanced driver's license (EDL)
- Enhanced identification card (EID)



Requirements:

- Proof of citizenship, identity, and residency

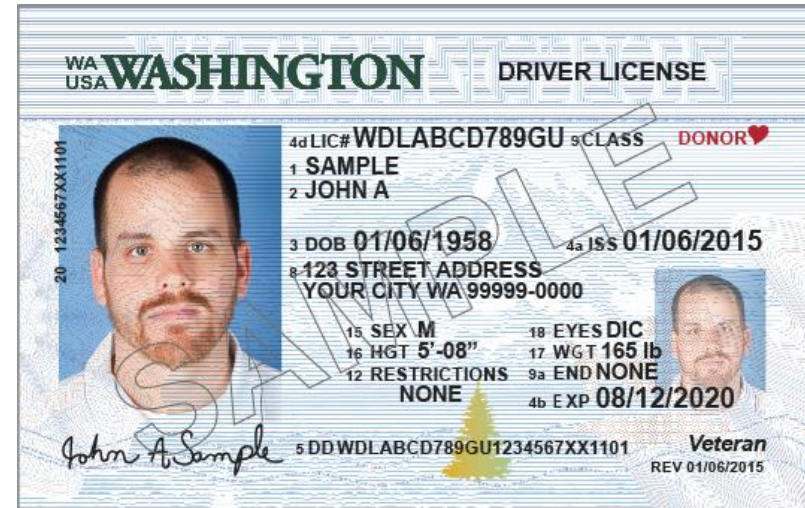


Washington issued standard documents (not Real ID compliant):

- Standard driver's license
- Standard identification card

Requirements:

- Proof of identity and residency



The REAL ID Act requires noncompliant cards (such as Washington's standard DL/ID) must:

“clearly state on their face and in the machine readable zone that the card is not acceptable for official purposes.”

NOTE: DHS must approve the state's proposed marking.

“Federal Limits Apply”

NOTE: This marking was previously approved by DHS for use by California.





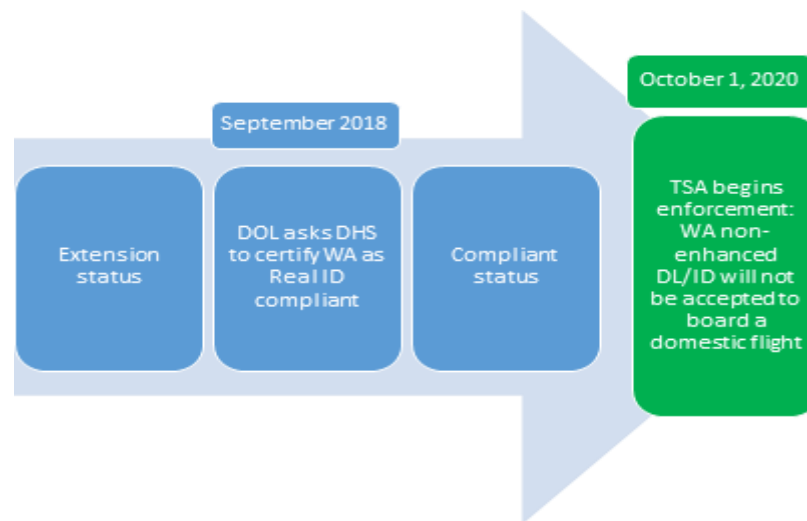

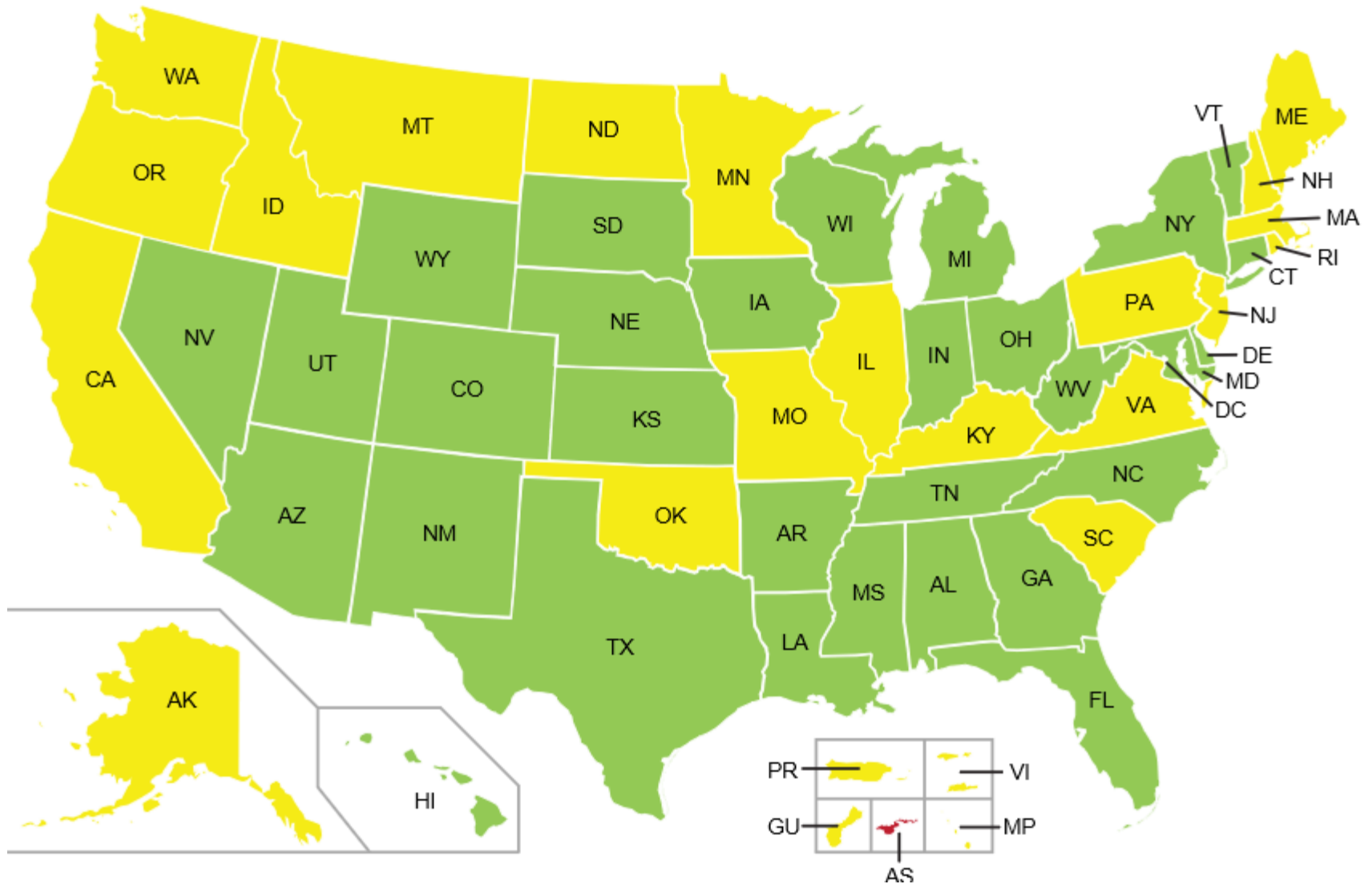

- Enforcement dates are established by DHS
- Enforcement at TSA will begin October 2020 for states with compliant or extension status
- Washington's current extension expires October 2018
- Washington is applying for full compliance in September 2018, so enforcement at TSA begins October 2020

Public information campaign will be launched in June to help residents understand their options





Do you have any of these forms of ID?
Yes: U.S. Passport, U.S. Military ID, U.S. Federal ID, U.S. State ID, U.S. Tribal ID, U.S. National ID, U.S. State ID, U.S. Tribal ID, U.S. National ID
No: REAL ID only affects people ages 18 & older

How about any of these?
Yes: In line or support-based ID of issued under a U.S. state or territory process, Federally recognized, tribal-issued photo ID, REAL ID (if) ever issued to same federal employee or federal contractor
No: REAL ID (if) ever issued to same federal employee or federal contractor

Do you regularly travel by plane, or plan to in the future?
Yes: You need a new ID by Oct 1, 2020
No: As long as you don't need to fly, you're covered. If you do decide to travel, you'll need a REAL ID (if) ever issued to same federal employee or federal contractor

What's ID2020?
Congress passed the REAL ID Act in 2005 to help combat terrorism and identity theft. The latest new identification requirement for domestic air travel and to enter some federal facilities. To comply, a state must create an ID that meets or exceeds the federal standard of identity and legal U.S. residency, as well as certain federal security features. All states must comply with the law before a later effect on Oct 1, 2020.

Where will I need to be Real ID-ready?
REAL ID will affect access to places controlled by the federal government.
Airport security checkpoints, U.S. border crossings, Some federal buildings, the military facilities

Can I still use a standard driver's license or ID card?
Yes, REAL ID only affects people who travel by plane or access certain federal facilities. You can continue to use your standard driver's license to drive, or use your standard ID to travel by train or state ferry, vote, and access health services.

- Real ID Act *impacts all U.S. states* and territories
- *Marking* on Washington's standard documents *begins July 1, 2018*
 - *Marking must be approved by Department of Homeland Security*
- Washington to seek full compliance in September 2018
- *Enforcement at airports (for domestic flights) will begin October 2020*
- Standard documents can still be used for for state identification, and for many other purposes
