


Access Improvements

The City of Yakima, Yakima County, and the State of Washington will invest more than \$100 million on road enhancements to improve access to the from throughout the rest of the Central Washington region.










Environmental Cleanup

- 28 acres of the Mill Site used to be home to a municipal landfill
- Extensive environmental analysis indicates potential hazardous materials still remain on the former landfill site
- The former landfill must be cleaned up in order to be redeveloped
- Current estimates place the cost of cleaning up the former landfill at \$15 million
