

## WSDOT Planning Role

...a statewide multimodal transportation plan in conformance with federal requirements, to ensure the continued mobility of people and goods within regions and across the state in a safe, cost-effective manner.

RCW 47.06.040



WASHINGTON TRANSPORTATION PLAN, PHASE 2—IMPLEMENTATION 2017 - 2040







The statewide multimodal transportation plan shall consist of:

- (1) A state-owned facilities component to guide state investment in highways including bicycle and pedestrian facilities, and state ferries; and
- (2) A state-interest component, defining the state's interest in aviation, marine ports and navigation, freight rail, intercity passenger rail, bicycle and pedestrian transportation, and public transportation; recommending actions in coordination with appropriate public and private transportation providers to ensure that the state interest in these transportation modes is met.






## What Does Technological Change Mean for Transportation, Land Use, the Economy, and the Environment?
