General Information

- Fleet Size: 98 vehicles
 - 14 Service Vehicles 32 Vanpool Vans
 - 21 Clallam Connect 31 Fixed Route
 - (32 Fueled by Propane)
- Operates 6 days per week One route on Sunday
- Just about 100 employees
- Supported by local sales tax and fares
- Connects with Jefferson Transit on both ends of County
- CTS Board is made up of eight elected officials + one ATU

Statistics

- CTS began operations October of 1980 with a fleet of 12 vehicles with 10 routes
- 2019 Operating Budget: \$9,934,800
- 2018 Miles Traveled (Fixed Route, Vanpool & Clallam Connect): 2,157,856 miles
- Ridership 2018: (Approx. .81% over 2017) Total Fixed Route = 710,987 boarding Total Clallam Connect = 64,222 boarding Total Vanpool = 98,791 boarding

- Ten Heavy-duty Diesel Replacement Coaches \$4,001,574


