



# Legislative History Fuel Tax / Road Usage Charge

2003/2004	Legislative Task Force, mileage-based funding
2015	HB 362 – UDOT study mileage-based revenues
2017	_SB 174 – Transportation Governance & Funding task force
2018	_SB 136 – RUC parameters, Advisory Committee
2019	_SB 72 – RUC framework, January 2020 enactment
2020	_SB 150 – 2031 RUC enrollment plan for all vehicles report
2021	_SB 82 – created dedicated revenue account for RUC
2022	_HB 186 – amended rate structure and enrollment criteria for alternative fuel vehicles






#### Flat Fee & Per-mile RUC Rate Options

#### Mileage-based Fee


1.52¢ / Mile





# Utah Fleet Composition by Vehicle Type









## Fuel Efficiency Distribution by Location Type






### Relative Fleet Distribution by Model Year & Fuel Type

#### **Enrollment Process**




Enroll online with name, license plate number, and VIN.

Complete CAM user agreement.




Submit initial odometer capture.



# RUC Program Enrollment Growth


#### **Cumulative Vehicle Enrollment**






# Miles Driven by Enrolled Vehicles

## **DMV** Integration

- Syncing annual registration cycle (and flat fee payments) with RUC enrollment
- Confirmation that RUC applicants' vehicles are eligible for program
- Ability to place registration holds for non-compliance and clear the holds once driver's paid debt





### Program Next Steps

#### **Local RUC Overlay & Tolling Pilot**

- Key Purposes:
  - Achieve admin cost savings by bundling technology, processes, and billing
  - Partner with tolling service providers and local government agencies to build broad support for RUC



#### **RUC Customer Service Optimization (STSFA Grant)**

- Key Purposes:
  - Identify and implement ways to improve the RUC customer experience so that the program is viewed favorably



# **RUC West 10-Yr Plan for Light Veh Implementation** (Utah Lead State)

- Key Purposes:
  - Identify best practices, challenges, and strategies to implement RUC broadly
