Transportation Resource Manual 2009-11 Update

Project Status

The Transportation Resource Manual was originally created by the Legislative Transportation Committee to document Washington's transportation funding and policy-making structure. It provides quick access to authoritative information that is particularly useful during session.

The Manual organizes transportation information into six categories:

- Legislative Role: Identifies the Legislative Committees responsible for state transportation policy and budget. Provides an overview of the transportation budget, including the effect of recent initiatives.
- Taxes, Fees and Other Revenue Sources: Provides detailed information on sources of transportation revenue, including historical and projected revenue streams. Includes information on state and local taxes and fees, as well as sources of federal funding.
- Funds and Accounts: Detailed information on transportation funds and accounts including the sources and uses of each fund or account.
- **Agencies and Jurisdictions:** Identifies and describes state, local, and regional transportation agencies and jurisdictions.
- **Modes:** Identifies and describes the statutory and legal environment for Washington's non-highway transportation modes.
- **Planning:** Identifies and describes Washington's state, local, and regional transportation plans.

Updated versions released prior to each biennial budget session include the latest changes and revenue forecasts. The 2009 version of the Transportation Resource Manual will be available prior to the 2009 Legislative session. It will be available in both hard-copy and on-line on the JTC website.
