






Blakeslee Junction to Grand Mound

Proposed Collector/Distributor - Yew St. Alternative








I-5 / MELLEN ST TO BLAKESLEE JUNCTION

POTENTIAL HARRISON AVE CONFIGURATION




EXISTING HARRISON AVE
