Response from McCleary plaintiffs

- Reporting process gives plaintiffs opportunity to respond to Committee's report.
- Plaintiffs' 2012 response argued that state failed to demonstrate "steady progress" toward implementing ESHB 2261 and "real and measurable progress" toward compliance with Article IX.
- Requested the court to take "firm action" if the 2013 budget failed to make "significant" progress toward full funding of ESHB 2261 reforms and Article IX compliance.
