

# Charge of the Joint Task Force on Education Funding

- Make recommendations on how the legislature can meet the requirements outlined in chapter 548, Laws of 2009 (ESHB 2261) and chapter 236, Laws of 2010 (SHB 2776).
  - Develop a proposal for a reliable and dependable funding mechanism to support basic education programs.
    - The proposal must, at a minimum, support full implementation of the programmatic enhancements required in ESHB 2261 and SHB 2776.
    - May recommend multiple funding options, but must recommend one preferred alternative.
  - Consider the specific recommendations for the transitional bilingual instructional program from the Quality Education Council to the Legislature.

## Alternative Funding Proposal Submitted to the Joint Task Force on Education Funding

- K-12 education programs appropriated first in a separate budget from current NGF-S revenues
- Separate appropriations budget to fund all other programs from remaining available NGF-S revenues
