Developmental Disability Service System Task Force Recommendations of legislative members December 4, 2012

- 1) Cap the number of people who may be served at an RHC at 1,000. Remove the names of the RHCs from statute.
- 2) Open all RHCs to receive new clients. This includes residents and clients receiving respite services, subject to the cap of 1,000.
- 3) The Department of Social and Health Services is to provide assessments of the 14,000 clients on the no paid services caseload. DSHS is to perform these assessments within available funds.
- 4) Modify the Dan Thompson trust to allow the sale of RHC property. Ensure that Francis Haddon Morgan is included in the trust language.
- 5) a. Propose vetoed section 7 as a bill for introduction during the 2013 legislative session, with modifications to address the Governor's veto message.
 - b. Propose legislation relating to DSHS authority to conduct investigations in community homes.
