




# Persons with DD in Washington State



\*Approximately 100,0000 persons have an intellectual/developmental disability, per prevalence rates


#### Number of DDD Clients by Caseload Type Between 2004 and 2011










# Top Ten: Self-Identified Needs (NPS Survey)



# Which of these other services and supports do you (or your family member) receive?




Do you get enough information about services and supports to help plan for what you (or your family member) needs?





## Where would you want to get this information?




If you (or family member) has a crisis and you need DDD services, do you know what to do?


