DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

Financial Assistance Programs and/or Employment Standards

• DOH administers very few programs that pay benefits or otherwise provide <u>financial</u> <u>assistance</u> directly to individuals.

One example is the <u>Women, Infant & Children's Nutrition</u> program which provides financial assistance to women and children to purchase nutritional foods.

• DOH does not administer or enforce any employment standards.

Other Programs

The Community and Family Health Division includes the Office of Community Wellness and Prevention; the Office of Infectious Disease and Reproductive Health; and the Office of Maternal and Child Health.

The Division of Environmental Health includes the Office of Drinking Water; the Office of Radiation Protection; the Office of Shellfish and Water Protection; the Office of Environmental Health and Safety; and the Office of Environmental Health Assessments.

DOH is also comprised of the Epidemiology, Health Statistics and Public Health Laboratories and the Health Systems Quality Assurance Divisions.
