Financial Assistance Programs and/or Employment Standards

• CTED administers very few programs that pay benefits or otherwise provide <u>financial assistance</u> directly to individuals.

One example is the <u>Mobile Home Relocation Assistance</u> program which provides financial assistance to homeowners forced to move their homes as a result of mobile home park closures. Reimbursements of certain expenses are paid directly to eligible homeowners.

CTED does not administer or enforce any employment standards.
