


Legislative Task Force on School Construction Funding

* Reflects the results from 6 out of 9 task force members.


What is your current satisfaction level with the components of the current state school construction formula?




What are the top areas that the Task Force should concentrate on in phase 2 of its work?

- Funding for property acquisitions.

Preliminary Scoping Issues for Phase 2

- How do you want to factor in the overall outlook for the state's capital budget and the impact of recent K-12 enhancements into your deliberations?
- What options exist to generate additional revenues from current sources of funding?
- Are there other state or local funding sources that you would like to consider dedicating to K-12 capital construction?

Preliminary Scoping Issues for Phase 2

- Are you comfortable with the current role impact fees play in school construction?
- Are there other financing mechanisms that could be employed to generate revenues for school construction?
- How should the system promote an appropriate level of school facility maintenance given school district limited resources?

Preliminary Scoping Issues for Phase 2

- Is there interest in reviewing the feasibility and desirability of a more significant overhaul of the state's method of funding school construction?
- Does the current system produce the needed type of school facilities? And is this true in all areas of the state?
- Are modifications needed to the current funding system based on statewide programmatic changes (eg. education reform, class size reduction, all day kindergarten, technology, etc)?
