

# Review Assignment Had Four Parts

Guided by criteria from the Sunset Act, JLARC reports back the degree to which it found ORA:

- 1. Complied with legislative intent (statutory directives and requirements; Chapter 43.42 RCW)
- 2. Reached its own performance goals and targets (front-end data plan; started July 2002)
- 3. Operated in an efficient and economical manner (environmental regulation and permitting help)
- 4. Undertook activities otherwise duplicated (by another state agency or the private sector)

# Reminder: Focus was Execution of Statutory Duties as Assigned to this Organization



#### Sunset Review: Conclusions in Brief

- 1. ORA can demonstrate it fully or partially complied with eight out of ten statutory duties.
- 2. ORA has been doing its work but has not invested adequate time to record and track sufficient details and outcomes.
- 3. Performance data shows the public has increasingly used this discretionary service. However, we cannot yet evaluate the Office's efficiency in providing regulatory assistance.
- 4. JLARC does not have evidence indicating ORA duplicates others' activities. Some stakeholders report ORA adds value to the process.

# Response to Recommendation

 The Legislature should repeal the June 30, 2007, sunset date (Chapter 43.131 RCW) which has the effect of reauthorizing ORA, and consider establishing a future sunset review in 2011.

**OFM and ORA: Concur** 

"A new sunset date will allow ORA to develop a collection plan and new performance measures in line with our current activities." – Director's Reply

# Response to Recommendation

2. ORA should develop an implementation plan by next March to remedy the agency's lack of information about its activities, and report to the Legislature on the results of this plan by June 2008 to demonstrate its performance and compliance with statutory duties.

#### **OFM and ORA: Concur**

"In addition, our implementation plan will include an updated approach for documenting how the office meets its statutorily required duties."—Director's Reply
