

CHAPTER 20.

RELATIVE TO APPEALS IN JUSTICE COURTS IN CIVIL
ACTIONS.

AN ACT amending Section 6754 of Ballinger's Annotated Codes and Statutes of Washington, being Section 3034 of Pierce's ^{6754 Bal-linger.} Washington Code, relating to appeals from Justice Courts in ³⁰³⁴ Pierce. civil action.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Section 6754 of Ballinger's Annotated Codes and Statutes of Washington, being Section 3034 of Pierce's Washington Code, is hereby amended to read as follows: Section 6754. Any person considering himself aggrieved by the judgment or decision of a Justice of the Peace in a civil action may, in person or by his agent, appeal therefrom to the Superior Court of the same county where the judgment was rendered or the decision made: *Provided*, there shall be no appeal allowed unless the amount in controversy exclusive of costs, shall exceed the sum of twenty dollars.
