

CHAPTER 10.

PIERCE'S WASHINGTON CODE.

AN ACT relating to the official code and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. The compilation by Frank Pierce of the session laws of the State of Washington, known as Pierce's Washington Code, is hereby adopted as an official compilation of the existing statutes up to and including the year 1919. Adoption.

SEC. 2. It shall be proper for the Legislature, in amending or repealing existing statutes, or for the courts in referring to existing statutes, to refer to or cite Pierce's Washington Code containing such law, and in any such references or citations to abbreviate the same as Pierce's Code. Reference to and abbreviation of.

SEC. 3. The Secretary of State is hereby authorized and directed to certify the laws of the present, seventeenth, session for publication as a part of said compilation. Certifying session laws.

SEC. 4. This act is necessary for the support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take effect immediately. Emergency.
