GAME AND GAME FISH—ALLOCATION OF RECEIPTS
FROM RESIDENT LICENSES.

AN ACT relating to the game code of the state of Washington,
and amending section 77.32.120, RCW.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of
Washington:*

Amendment.

SECTION 1. Section 77.32.120, RCW, as derived
from section 3, chapter 128, Laws of 1947, is amended
to read as follows:

Allocation.

Twenty percent of all moneys received from the
sale of resident state and county hunting and fishing
licenses may be used to acquire lands for public
hunting and fishing areas, small game habitat areas
and rights of way thereto and for the development
and maintenance of such areas for recreational and
game purposes.
