Said appropriation shall be disbursed under and subject to the provisions and limitations of said act of February 21, 1899.

DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATION FOR STATE BOARD OF HEALTH.

AN ACT making an appropriation for the State Board of Health for the remainder of the fiscal year ending March 31st, 1901.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Deficiency appropriation.

SECTION 1. That the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars be appropriated out of the general funds of the state, not otherwise appropriated, for the expenses of the State Board of Health for the remainder of the fiscal year ending March 31, 1901.
