DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATION FOR STATE BOARD OF ARCHITECT EXAMINERS.

AN ACT making an appropriation from the general fund for the State Board of Architect Examiners and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. The sum of Twenty-four Hundred (\$2400.00) Dollars, or so much thereof as may be found necessary, is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the salaries and expenses of the State Board of Architect Examiners; *Provided*, that expenditures hereunder shall not exceed the collections of said board. Appropriation \$2,400.00.

SEC. 2. This appropriation shall be available for the payment of salaries and expenses heretofore incurred by said board subsequent to April 1, 1919, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 205 of the Laws of 1919, for which payment has not been made. Use.

SEC. 3. This act is necessary for the support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take effect immediately. Emergency.
