

CHAPTER 8.

[S. B. 8.]

SOCIAL, CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL ASSOCIATIONS.

AN ACT relating to "An Act to provide for the incorporation of associations for social, charitable and educational purposes," and amending Section 4623, Pierce's Washington Code.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That section 4623, Pierce's Washington Code, be amended to read as follows:

Section 4623. At such first meeting, including any necessary or reasonable adjournment, an organization shall be effected by the choice by ballot of a temporary secretary, and by the adoption of by-laws, and the election of a president, secretary, treasurer and a board of trustees, not less than three nor more than thirty-six in number, and such other officers as may be provided for by the by-laws. At such first meeting no person shall be eligible as an officer or trustee who has not subscribed to the agreement of the association, but any corporation now or hereafter organized under this act, may, by a by-law, increase or diminish the number of trustees, within the limits hereinbefore provided. The temporary secretary shall make and attest a record of the proceedings until the secretary has been chosen.
